Use brass and aluminum cylinders while controlling for mass and volume to make the property of density more obvious.

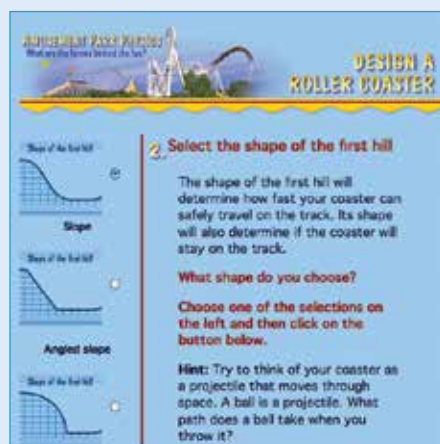


American Robin: Build a Robin's Nest

Ask questions before reading about how robins build nests, revisit the text for details, reflect on what's learned and get Writer's Workshop ideas.

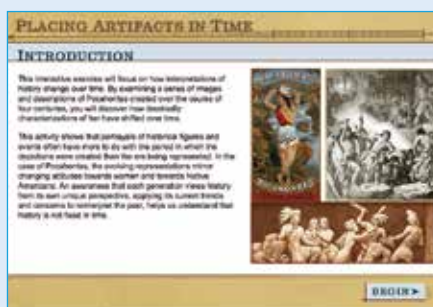
